





Fit the disc on the wheel hub.




Push the piston back. On models with a handbrake screw in the piston and align the fresh air bore hole in front of the bleed screw.




Assemble the pads complete with special tooth on the piston side.

Replace the clip on the pad pin.




Reconnect the brake cable.




Depress the brake pedal several times to bring the pads together.









Disconnect the wear sensors.




Remove the pin. Disconnect the wear sensor from its runner.
